The following suggestions should help making the child or children you are sponsoring a bit easier. While some sheets are very specific, others might be very vague or even blank. This is simply due to the information that is made available to us by the caseworkers or family members. So, with this in mind, please remember that all suggestion are just that, suggestions. We ask that you do only what you feel you can.

Example: To sponsor a four year old girl, you might consider:

All for approximately \$75 to \$100, this will delight the child as well as assist with needs.
